



## Co-curricular Activities

With a focus on nurturing and supporting the passions of our students, we have a range of lunchtime clubs and activities for students to participate in outside of the classroom, such as:

- **Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Group** - Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students gather in a yarning circle for discussions and communal problem solving.
- **Acapella** - The most advanced choir that St Ursula's runs, with quite complex pieces performed. Membership is via audition.
- **Art Club** - A place to connect with like-minded people, bring in projects to work on or seek advice from peers. Anyone can join.
- **ASPIRE** - Study assistance that provides an opportunity for Junior students to develop good study habits with the assistance of Senior students.
- **Book Club** - For students who love reading to come together to discuss the books they are reading.
- **Chess Club** - Students can learn to play or improve their standard of chess. Some weeks there are lessons and some weeks are competitions.
- **Code Ninjas** - A club run by students for students, with activities including coding competitions, robotics, drones and 3D printing.
- **Concert Band** - College band that performs at school and in the community on a regular basis and eisteddfods where able. Students need to own and be able to play an instrument.
- **Debating** - Provides students with the ability to debate against students from other schools in the longest running debating competition available in the Sydney metropolitan area.
- **Garden Club** - A collaborative group setup to maintain and develop the STEM Garden.



- **Hellenic Club** - For those with an appreciation for Greek culture.
- **J-club** - Year 7-8 students gather together to share their love of Japanese culture and language.
- **Junior Choir** - For Year 7-8 students. All are welcome as the main goal is to have fun singing as a group.
- **K-pop Club** - For those with an appreciation for Korean pop culture and language.
- **Mandarin Language Classes** - For those wishing to learn Mandarin or develop their existing understanding of the language.
- **Mock Trial** - Get practical experience in what it would be like to run a court case in a competitive setting.
- **Public Speaking** - An opportunity to practice the art of rhetoric in a highly competitive, yet rewarding environment.
- **Rosary** - A weekly Rosary where all are welcome to attend.
- **Runners' Club** - A great way to start the morning! No matter if you run, jog or walk, all staff and students are welcome to attend.
- **SEA Club** - Working to minimise our impact on the environment and creating opportunities for the community to make their contribution.
- **String Ensemble** - String players of all levels and ages play classical and popular music.
- **St Ursula's Dance Company** - Dance groups perform dances in a range of styles including contemporary dance, hip hop, tap and jazz.
- **Ursula Voices** - Year 9-12 students. A slightly more advanced choir with singing in three parts and performing mainly pop/musical theatre style repertoire.



- **Voices of Tomorrow** - Run by Year 12 students, where people of all year groups come together to discuss a variety of important current issues in a respectful way.
